#### Health Department

**Illinois law requires parents be aware:** Vision screening is not a substitute for a complete eye and vision evaluation by an eye doctor. Your child is not required to undergo this vision screen if an optometrist has completed and signed a report from indicating that an examination has been administered within the previous 12 months. Screening is **NOT** an option unless the vision and hearing examination from the doctor is on file so we need **ALL forms** back since this is a mandatory program for all 3,4,5 year olds.
